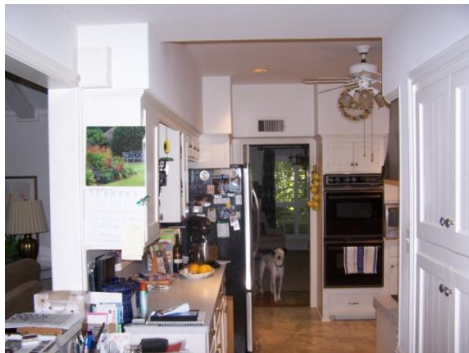




An Edge that my Aunt Josie would love...

Reverse OG is an upgrade edge that really doesn't look very impressive, ahhh but FEEL it! My aunt would love my comparison.

My 8 year old self asked her once, "Why are you putting lace on the inside of this dress?" Always the perfectionist, she was sewing lace seam binding into the hem of her latest creation. She fashioned a garment of the finest fabric and skillfully tailored it to fit her petite frame while I pestered her. I couldn't understand wasting something beautiful where, "No one will see it!" Choosing to complement the necessary function with a bit of elegance, she would say, "Yes, but I will know it is there!" This approach was her unique signature on each project she produced.
