Shortly after we were chosen to become **Silestone distributors in 2002** we were invited to tour the Silestone manufacturing facility in Spain. During the tour of the state of the art plant we learned about the relatively new material then called “engineered stone”, a **natural quartz surface** formed on Breton machinery specifically designed for the process. Heat and pressure applied to the mostly dry mix results in slabs, polished to a shine with a virtually indestructible finish.
